But one day on the track, I bumped another Greyhound when we were going 40mph. The next thing I knew, I was hurtling head over heals across the track until I came to a stop with a thud on the dirt. I had no idea what happened, but when I tried to get up I couldn't, because my leg hurt, a LOT! I had broken my hock. I don't remember crying, but I'm sure I did.



Then I was rescued



Fortunately, Southern Arizona Greyhound Adoption swept me up into their care, and soon I was at the vet's getting x-rayed, and then having surgery.

Turns out my hock wasn't just broken, it was shattered. I had 3 large broken fragments in my leg, and a bunch of crushed pieces. I told you that was a pretty scary wipeout I had.

My surgeon pinned and wired together 2 of the largest bone fragments and stabilized my entire foot. Now I'm in a big goofy cast waiting for everything to heal. And I'm trying really hard to be good and rest, just like the doctor told me to.

But I still have bills to pay

Now my problem is, my surgery cost \$4,000 and I don't have that kind of money. My wonderful adoption group has raised over \$3500 towards the total cost, so I only need about \$400 more to pay my surgeon. If I could get back on the racetrack and earn the money, I would. But unfortunately, there will be no more racing for me.

Can you help me?
