1	Fade in:	Music up:
2	Opening title sequence Entheos Hearing Clinic	Happy music.
3	Jordan footage? Entheos sign, etc.	NARRATOR: Welcome to the Entheos hearing clinic. We're very glad you're here, and we want to help you take good care of your ears.
4	Shots of Jordan Entheos crew unloading bus and setting up stuff.	We're a group of audiologists and volunteers who travel all over the world helping people just like you.
5	Shots of audiologists in Jordan getting their equipment set up.	Audiologists are specially trained in how the ear works. And if your ears aren't working right, we have ways to help you hear better.

6	Jane greets Abigail and her parents at the clinic.	Helping you hear better starts with one of our audiologists giving you a hearing test.
7	Jane, Abigail and parents walk over to Jane's station.	This lets us check your ears and find out how much you can really hear. Don't worry, it won't hurt, and it might even tickle a little bit.
8	Shots of parent filling out forms, with Abigail looking on and helping with answers.	Your hearing test begins with some questions about your ears, your hearing and your health. So there'll be a few forms to fill out.
9	Jane finishes looking over the forms and puts the down. She picks up otoscope and starts examining Abigail's ear.	Next, an audiologist will use a special light to look in your ears. This lets them see your ear canals and eardrums.

10	Jane continues to look in Abigail's ears. Reaction shots.	This way, they can tell if there's earwax in your ear canal or an infection in your middle ear. Either of these things can affect your hearing.
11	Shot of Hannah removing earwax.	Earwax is easy to fix. The audiologist will use a long thin tool to gently remove the wax from your ear. You might feel a little tickle, but that's about it.
12	Shot of Hannah talking to Abigail.	If you have an infection in your ear, we'll make sure that gets treated too.
13	Hannah finishes and Abigail gets up from the chair.	Then, it's time to begin the actual hearing test.
14	Jane and Abigail and parents walk into quiet room.	For this test we'll have you sit in a quiet room.

15	<p>Jane puts headphones on Abigail.</p> <p>CS – audio test dials.</p>	<p>The audiologist will put headphones on you and play different sounds in your ears.</p>
16	<p>Abigail raises her hand when she hears sounds.</p>	<p>You'll raise your hand whenever you hear the sounds. Easy, right?</p>
17	<p>Abigail tosses toys into the basket.</p>	<p>Or we might play a game and have you toss a toy into a basket every time you hear a sound. How fun is that?</p>
18	<p>Jane and Abigail interacting during the hearing test.</p>	<p>This helps the audiologist know how well you can hear different things.</p>
19	<p>The test is done and Jane takes off Abigail's headphones.</p>	<p>When that's done, the audiologist may do another test to check your eardrums.</p>

20	<p>Jane puts different device in Abigail's ear. Does whatever. Goes to other ear.</p> <p>Takes device out. Abigail and Jane smile at each other.</p>	<p>This test won't hurt either, although your ear will feel full for just a moment. And then it will go back to normal really quick.</p>
21	<p>Jane and Abigail and her parents talk about the test results.</p>	<p>When these tests are done, the audiologist will talk to you and your family about what to do next.</p>
22	<p>More shots of Jane talking to Abigail and her parents.</p>	<p>Depending on what's wrong with your ears, we may be able to help you today by fitting you with a hearing aid.</p>
23	<p>Abigail waiting for Jane to squish plastic into her ear.</p>	<p>This part's easy too.</p>

24	<p>Jane mixes up the plastic with a knife.</p> <p>Then Jane squooshes the soft plastic into Abigail's ear.</p>	<p>First the audiologist will mix up some special putty, and then squish it into your ears. This is how they make molds of the insides of your ears.</p>
25	<p>Waits a moment, then pulls the mold out.</p> <p>Shots of Jordan volunteer making a hearing aid.</p>	<p>After a few minutes, the putty will harden and the audiologist will remove them. Then we'll take your ear molds and fit them onto hearing aids.</p>
26	<p>Abigail reading a magazine in the waiting room.</p>	<p>This may take a little time since we'll be helping a lot of people, so please be patient.</p>

27	Shots of Jane putting hearing aid into the Abigail's ear.	But once they're ready, the audiologist will fit you with your new hearing aids and make sure they're comfortable.
28	Jane turns on the hearing aid and adjusts them with her computer.	They'll use a computer to adjust the hearing aids so they're just right for you. Then they'll turn them on.
29	Abigail's face lights up.	And you'll be surprised at what you can hear.
30	Shots of different kids reacting to sounds from the Jordan mission.	Like your parent's voices. And music, and laughter. And your friends playing. And your school lessons. And a lot of other things that would take too long to list here.

31	Shots of happy kid faces.	But we think you're going to like all these new sounds, and how it will change your life.
32	More shots from Jordan missions of happy customers.	So just relax and let us take care of your ears. We're pretty sure you'll be happy you did.
